

IMMUNIZATION INJECTIONS

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I. CPT¹ PROCEDURE CODES

90378, 90476, 90633, 90700 - 90749

II. DESCRIPTION

The process of rendering a subject immune, most frequently accomplished by immunization with either live or inactivated viral agents or bacterial antigens (active immunization) or by administration of performed antibody after an exposure to a disease has occurred (passive immunization).

III. POLICY

A. Coverage will be extended for the age appropriate dose of vaccines recommended and adopted by CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). Refer to CDC's home page (<http://www.cdc.gov/>) for current schedule of recommended vaccines.

B. Well-child immunizations for beneficiaries from birth to age six.

C. Immunizations required by dependents of active duty military personnel who are traveling outside the United States as a result of an active duty member's duty assignment, and such travel is being performed under orders issued by a Uniformed Service.

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
