II. POLICY

A. Special education instruction, other than training listed in [Chapter 9, Section 10.1](#), specifically designed to accommodate the disabling effects of a qualifying condition may be cost-shared subject to all applicable PFPWD requirements.

B. Identification of appropriate public facilities. The local educational agency with responsibility for the beneficiary is the sole public facility to provide public facility use certification for special education services.

C. Services cost-shared through the PFPWD may be provided by an authorized institutional or individual professional provider on an inpatient or outpatient basis and rendered in the beneficiary's natural environment. This includes at home, at school, or other location that is suitable for the type of services being rendered.

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
